The ASPRO Project holds a performance evaluation and preparation workshop for the second phase

As part of the continuous activities of the Aviation Safety Professional Diploma (ASPRO) project, and with the support of the European Union's Erasmus+ Programme, the partner universities and institutions carried out a series of preparatory and evaluative measures aimed at ensuring the effective implementation of training workshops and achieving sustainable educational outcomes in the field of aviation safety.



1. Initial Preparation and Implementation

The working teams, which include representatives from Amman Arab University, Jordan University of Science and Technology, and Al-Balqa Applied University, commenced the following tasks:

- Preparing a detailed timeline for the upcoming training workshop.
- Defining the educational objectives and curriculum in line with the quality standards approved in the project.
- Holding the inaugural meeting to review the action plan and discuss implementation steps
- Emphasizing the importance of continuous follow-up after the training to ensure the practical application of acquired knowledge.



2. Systematic Evaluation and Follow-up

Evaluation and follow-up procedures were implemented rigorously to ensure the achievement of the desired objectives:

- Carefully monitoring attendance and interaction during the workshop sessions.
- Preparing field reports documenting the implementation stages and the level of progress in the work.
- Evaluating the acquired learning outcomes and verifying their alignment with the project's objectives.
- Enhancing effective coordination among participants from the various partner universities and colleges .



3. Project Management and Final Reports

As part of the project management tasks, the data analysis and reporting phase was completed:

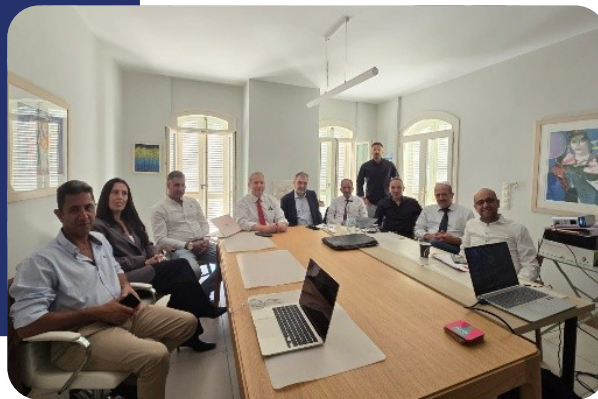
- Conducting a detailed analysis of the evaluation results to identify strengths and opportunities for development.
